Allocation Appeals Policy

It is our practice to allow an agency to appeal the funding decision made by the Board of Directors.

Final determination will be based upon the following:

1. Significantly new or clarifying information that was not presented to the impact area committee but was unavailable at the time of the review.
2. Substantial factual error, misunderstanding or incorrect analysis by the issue team member(s) who reviewed your organization's grant application.
3. Allegations of bias, fraud or misuse of funds by the United Way Board.

The Board of Directors or Executive Committee of the appellant agency must take action within 30 days of the receipt of allocation notification, by submitting a written statement of appeal to the Board Chair of the United Way of Alamance County.

The Board Chair, or designee, will then schedule a time for the agency to give a 10-minute presentation to the Appeals Committee. The Appeals Committee will be chaired by the United Way Board Chair and will include equal members from Issue Team Chairs and Board Members of United Way. The Appeals Committee Chair will present the appeal information and recommendation to the Board of Directors or Executive Committee of United Way. The Board of Directors or Executive Committee of United Way will make a decision and will notify the agency within 10 working days after the presentation to the Appeals Committee Chair.
