Let us do your taxes for **FREE** and claim any credits such as the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) or Child Tax Credit (CTC) that you have earned:

- ★ Federal EIC up to \$6,318 per year and/or CTC up to \$2,000 per child.
- ★ If you have a valid Social Security Number, are married (filing jointly), have 3 (or more) children, and made less than \$54,00 last year you may qualify for both of these credits.

Please bring the following  
to your appointment:

- ✓ Picture ID for yourself (and your spouse, if applicable)
- ✓ Social Security cards for yourself and all other individuals on your return (spouse and all dependents)
- ✓ Your prior year tax return
- ✓ All income documents including W-2s, 1099s and other tax documents
- ✓ Healthcare tax documents including Forms 1095 A, B, or C, Marketplace Exemption Letters, etc.
- ✓ Form 1098-T and other documentation of higher education expenses including tuition/student loan interest paid
- ✓ Daycare expenses and the daycare provider's name, address and tax ID number
- ✓ Documentation or a detailed listing to support itemized deductions, if applicable. This may include items such as: - Mortgage loan interest paid- Charitable contributions- Property taxes paid (home and auto)- Medical expenses
- ✓ Financial statements or other documents to support retirement plan rollovers
